

SPORTING REGULATIONS 2022

1. Championship

This is the Sporting Regulations for NEZ North European BMW 325 Championship 2022 (Short: NEZ BMW). These Sporting Regulations come into force from the moment they are published on the NEZ web-site: <u>www.fia-nez.eu</u> where possible changes, bulletins etc, will be published.

2. Title and Jurisdiction

NEZ Endurance is supervised by the NEZ Racing Commission in association with respective ASN's Racing Commissions or their representatives within the NEZ. The entrants are enforced to follow the General Sporting Regulations from hosting ASN, Supplementary Regulations of each Round and the Regulations set by the Promoter – "Autosporta klubs X sports" (Latvia). Competitors must ensure that their cars comply with the conditions of eligibility and safety throughout qualifying and racing.

3. Eligible Competitors

The events will be national and are open to Teams with an appropriate, valid ASN issued license, including starting permission from their respective ASN. Only participants with a license issued by an ASN within the NEZ-countries can score points in the NEZ BMW.

4. Eligible Cars

Rounds in the NEZ BMW are exclusively limited to racing cars which comply with the BaTCC Technical Regulations for BMW 325 class, published on BaTCC web-site: <u>www.batcc.eu/about-terms</u> no later than 01.02.2022.

5. Championship Rounds

Each round will consist of minimum two practice sessions, one qualifying and two race finals, each of the distance 30 – 60 km or 15-30 minutes, whichever fits better for the organizer of the event.

6. Points scoring and determination of the winner.

- 6.1. At the end of the season, there will be one winner NEZ North European BMW 325 Champion.
- 6.2. Every actually held round will count towards the NEZ BMW Championship.
- 6.3. Participants will be awarded with the number of points per each actually held round, throughout the season based on the following table:

- 6.4. Maximum number of participants allowed on the starting grid of each race final is set to be 36. In case of more entries, special rules to apply in accordance with the BaTCC Sporting Regulations 2022, which will be published on BaTCC web-site: <u>www.batcc.eu/about-terms</u> no later than 01.02.2022
- 6.5. In order to be classified in the certain race final, the participant must complete at least 50% (fifty percent) of the distance completed by the winner of the race. DNQ status is determined to the participants completed less than 50% (fifty percent) of the distance in the race completed by the winner.
- 6.6. Participant, who collects the greatest number of points at the end of the racing season will be determined as the NEZ North European BMW 325 Champion.

NEZ BMW 325 Championship

- 6.7. If two or more participants finish the NEZ BMW with the same number of points, the higher place in the overall standings shall be awarded to:
 - a) the participant who is the holder of the greatest number with the highest places throughout the season;
 - b) this process will repeat itself through all available finishing positions until the winner is produced;
 - c) if this process fails to produce the winner, the participant which gets higher place in the last actually held round of the NEZ BMW will become a winner;

7. Entries

- 7.1. In order to be eligible to score series points participants must enter the NEZ BMW series. The entry has to be made via web site of the promoter of the series: <u>www.batcc.eu</u>
- 7.2. Participants are responsible for sending (directly or indirectly via local ASNs) in correct and complete entry.
- 7.3. The registration for the series is open on 1st of January 2022 and closes one day prior the last round.
- 7.4. The NEZ BMW will become legitimate unless there are minimum number of entries 3 (three) throughout the season.

8. Free Practice, Qualifying and Finals

- 8.1. Free practice and qualifying sessions, as well as the race itself are always held in accordance with the official organizer's time-table of each round.
- 8.2. The starting grids for both race finals of each round will determined in accordance with the BaTCC Sporting Regulations 2022, which will be published on BaTCC web-site: <u>www.batcc.eu/about-terms</u> no later than 01.02.2022.

9. Time-keeping

All competitors must have their own or rented time-keeping transponder, which are mounted and in working condition while the car is on the track (free practice, qualifying and race finals).

10. Entry fee for Championship and Rounds

- 10.1. The entry fee for NEZ BMW is set to be the same as for the Baltic Touring Car (BaTCC) series and determined in the BaTCC Sporting Regulations 2022, which will be published on BaTCC web-site: <u>www.batcc.eu/about-terms</u> no later than 01.02.2022.
- 10.2. The entry fee must be paid before the race but not later than the closing of the NEZ BMW championship registration.
- 10.3. In case BaTCC entry fee is paid, there is no need to pay additional NEZ BMW championship fee.
