

LATVIJAS DRIFTA KAUSA JUNIORU KAUSS

No 2023. gada sezonas Latvijas Drifta kausa ieskaitei oficiāli tiek pievienots JUNIORU KAUSS.

Junioru kauss norisināsies Latvijas Drifta kausa STREET klases ieskaitē 2023. gada sezonas ietvaros.

Junioru kausa ieskaites nosacījumi:

- Junioru kausa ieskaitē piedalās visi sportisti, kuri, uzsākot 2023. gada sezonu vai piedaloties konkrētajās sacensībās, nav sasniegusi 18 gadu vecumu, un kuri brauc gan pilnu, gan nepilnu sezonu Latvijas Drifta kausa STREET klases ieskaitē.
- Ja sportists piedalās Latvijas Drifta kausa STREET ieskaitē pilnu sezonu ar gada licenci, un sezonas laikā sportistam paliek 18 gadi, sportists tāpat skaitīsies arī Junioru kausu ieskaitē.
- Ja sportists nav izņēmis gada licenci, bet piedalās kādā no Drifta kausa STREET klases posmiem, tad tiks ņemts vērā, vai posma norises datumos sportistam ir / nav 18 gadi. Ja sportistam nav 18 gadi posma norises datumos, sportists automātiski tiek pievienots Junioru kausa sezonas kopvērtējumam.
- Junioru kausa sezonas kopvērtējums tiek atsevišķi izvilkts no Latvijas Drifta kausa STREET klases sezonas kopvērtējuma balstoties uz Latvijas Drifta Kausa STREET klases sezonas nolikumu 2023.gadam.
- LAF Drifta komisijas apbalvošanā atsevišķi tiek apbalvota Latvijas Drifta kausa Junioru ieskaite.
- LAF Drifta komisijai, konsultējoties ar organizatoru pirms sacensībām un izvērtējot pieteikto dalībnieku skaitu, ir tiesības Junioru kausam izveidot atsevišķus tandēmus kā papildus tandēmu ieskaiti sacensībās. Pie šādas situācijas punkti papildus par tandēmiem Junioru ieskaitē braucējam netiks piešķirti, bet organizatoram ir tiesības taisīt atsevišķu apbalvošanu arī posma ieskaitē Junioriem. Precizitātei jāmin, ja Juniors ir nokvalificējies STREET tandēmiem, viņš brauc abas tandēmu ieskaites.

ENGLISH

From the 2023 season, the JUNIOR CUP is officially added to the Latvian Drift Cup.

The Junior Cup will take place in the STREET class competition of the Latvian Drift Cup as part of the 2023 season.

Junior Cup qualifying conditions:

- All drivers who have not reached the age of 18 when starting the 2023 season or participating in the specific competition, and who drive both full and part-time in the Latvian Drift Cup STREET class competition, participate in the Junior Cup.
- If the driver participates in the Latvian Drift Cup STREET class competition for a full season with an annual license, and the driver turns 18 during the season, the driver will be included in the Junior Cup.
- If the driver doesn't have the annual license, but participates in one of the Drift Cup STREET class stages, it will be taken into account whether the driver is/is not 18 years old on the dates of the stage. If the driver is not 18 years old on the dates of the stage, the driver is automatically added to the overall standings of the Junior Cup.
- The overall standings of the Junior Cup is taken from the overall standing of the Latvian Drift Cup STREET class based on the Latvian Drift Cup STREET class season regulations for 2023.
- The Junior Cup is awarded additionally in the Gala awards ceremony of LAF Drift commission.
- The LAF Drift Commission, after consulting with the organizer before the competition and evaluating the number of registered junior participants, has the right to create separate tandems for the Junior Cup as an additional tandem entry in the competition. In such a situation, additional points for tandems in the Junior tandems will not be given to the driver, but the organizer has the right to give a separate award also in the stage for Juniors.

To be precise, if Junior has qualified for STREET tandems, he drives both tandem events.
