5. CLASSES

5.1. The cars are divided into classes according to the calculated engine capacity, construction type:

- PORSCHE GT3 CUP – ~~in compliance with SPORTING & TECHNICAL REGULATIONS 24H SERIES powered by Hankook 2023.~~ **PORSCHE GT3 CUP cars: 997.2, 991.1, 991.2 and 992 cars. All cars must comply to technical manuals issued by the car manufacturer (Porsche AG).**

6.2. Weighing procedure (BMW 325 CUP, DIESEL, TC1, TC2, TC3, GT AM **and GT PRO (excluding cars from the table 5.3)**). Minimum weight is the weight of the car with driver, driver's equipment, all operating fluids and a minimum 3 litres of fuel in the tank.

6.3. Weighing procedure (**cars from the table 5.3 and PORSCHE GT3 CUP** ~~GT PRO and PORSCHE 991~~). Minimum weight is the weight of the car without driver, without driver's equipment and without fuel in the tank.
